How to set up and play





1 Print each play dough mat on A4 paper. Laminate each sheet to create a sturdy set.

2 Make or buy play dough in a range of appealing colours. You could add scents or eco-glitter to make it more fun!


3 Students use the dough to form each upper and lowercase letter inside the outlines provided, find and cover the focus letter within a group of letters, and then build an object that begins (or ends for 'the letter 'x') with the focus sound.

4 Variation: use everyday objects such as beads, counters, dice, shells or small pebbles to form and cover each letter.






Cover the  sacks.




Make spots for the socks.








Cover the  apples.

Cover the  teapots.




Make a tail for the tiger.




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Cover the  pencils.



Make toppings for the pizza.




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Cover the  insects.




Make ice bricks for the igloo.
